**The Fourth Annual Region 3 Mid-Atlantic Radon Stakeholders' Meeting
 will be held June 2, 2015 from 8:00am-5:00pm

This meeting is being held at no cost for all those that have a stake in protecting the public from unnecessary exposure to radon in their homes, schools and businesses.

The Stakeholder's meeting is being hosted by the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors (CRCPD), in collaboration with the Region 3 office of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, Virginia Department of Health, Delaware Department of Health and Social Services, West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources and the District of Columbia Department of the Environment. This meeting will bring interested stakeholders together to discuss common issues, provide insight into future radon risk reduction action, share perspectives, educate and network. This meeting will focus on radon risk reduction and looking at the latest developments in housing policy and science. Speakers include internationally recognized radon experts, the US Environmental Protection Agency and local radon professionals. Attendees will receive 4 hours of Category II CE credits for attending the June 2nd Stakeholder meeting.
