Work Plan Requirements

When submitting a work plan to the wells permitting module in the Surface and Groundwater Systems (SGS), the work plan must include the following information:

- 1. SB number from DCRA permits, Tracking Number from DDOT permits
- 2. Project street address
- 3. Square and lot
- 4. Project description:
 - a. Description of purpose of the project;
 - b. Number of borings;
 - c. Diameter and depth of borehole;
 - d. Drilling method and procedures; and
 - e. Abandonment process
- 5. Subsurface utility clearance
- 6. How to manage Investigation Derived Wastes (IDWs)
- 7. A description of the proposed well construction activity, well construction materials and equipment
- 8. Details of decontamination procedures (if the site is potentially or known-to-be contaminated)
- 9. The type and mix ratio of the grout, including how the grout will be inserted.
- 10. State that DOEE will receive, via email, the following:
 - a. A drilling notification, 2 days prior to drilling for inspection purposes; and
 - b. A completion/abandonment report within 60 days of completion/abandonment
- 11. Abandonment of wells, state that such report will contain the following:
 - a. Soil boring logs:
 - b. DC Well Construction Completion/Abandonment form;
 - c. Site figure depicting boring locations; and
 - d. Photographs showing the abandonment procedure
- 12. Name and signature of the representative, and date.
- 13. Any other relevant information
